### Changes for the 2010-2011 season

Classes:

- ISR has changed the age group for the Junior 10-14 class to the ages of 10-13 this season.
- The Sport Womens and Pro Womens class, due to lack of numbers, will now be combined and become the Pro Am Women class.
- The Pro Plus 30 class will become the Pro Am Plus 30 class.
- Semi Pro Open class will no longer exist in either National or Regional. The Semi Pro Super Stock class will be the featured class.
- The age of the Champ 7-14 class will now be Champ 6-12?

### Regional News

- The schedules will now consist of two full days of racing. You will do two rounds and a final for each day. You can either run Saturday or Sunday or both. There will be year-end championships for each day and an overall champion.
- Pro-AM Stock/Open will be offered at the Regionals. This regional class will encourage the use of stock sleds, but it will also provide an option to run an open sled. If a racer (Pro, Semi Pro or Plus racer) chooses to run an open sled at MN Regional, they will ONLY be eligible for the Pro-Am Stock/Open class, and will not be allowed to run in any of the stock classes with a different (stock) sled. The goal is to keep costs down for racers by eliminating the need for two sleds.

### National News

- National Semi Pros and Pros can register for any of the 8 National events. Pro Am Women and Pro Am Plus 30 will race at 5 National events – Duluth, TBA, Hayward, Minneapolis, and Lake Geneva.
- All other classes for certain events will need to pre-qualify through their regionals and will be invited based on their regional performance. Duluth and Geneva will remain as they historically have, first come, first serve until entries are full with top regional ISOC affiliate riders having first priority .
